



Officials During Matches – Timekeeper

(applies to all age groups)

- At any season fixture match, it is desirable that each team supply one (1) Timekeeper.
- Timekeepers must agree on match time prior to the siren being sounded.
- The siren must sound until acknowledged by the field umpire.
- Timekeeper must be a suitable age.
- Timekeeper must abide by the AFL Officials Code of Conduct.

Games Times by Age group:

U8 Mixed & U9 Girls: Quarters-10 Mins, $\frac{1}{4}$ & $\frac{3}{4}$ Time Breaks = 3 Mins (Max); $\frac{1}{2}$ Time Break = 6 Mins (Max); Football **Size=1**; Football Type=Synthetic.

U9s & U10 Mixed & U11 Girls: Quarters-10 Mins, $\frac{1}{4}$ & $\frac{3}{4}$ Time Breaks = 3 Mins (Max); $\frac{1}{2}$ Time Break = 6 Mins (Max); Football **Size=2**; Football Type=Synthetic.

U11s Mixed, U13 Boys & U13 Girls: Quarters-15 Mins, $\frac{1}{4}$ & $\frac{3}{4}$ Time Breaks = 5 Mins (Max); $\frac{1}{2}$ Time Break = 10 Mins (Max); Football **Size=3**; Football Type=Leather.

U15 Boys, U15 Girls & U17 Girls Quarters-15 Mins, $\frac{1}{4}$ & $\frac{3}{4}$ Time Breaks = 5 Mins (Max); $\frac{1}{2}$ Time Break = 10 Mins (Max); Football **Size=4**; Football Type=Leather.

U17 Boys: Quarters-20 Mins, $\frac{1}{4}$ & $\frac{3}{4}$ Time Breaks = 5 Mins (Max); $\frac{1}{2}$ Time Break = 15 Mins (Max); Football **Size=5**; Football Type=Leather.
